Requirements for show participation:

- Annual NAG membership current at registration deadline.
- Each member may submit up to three pieces of framed/3D artwork and up to three pieces of bin art. Framed artwork previously shown in a Nature Artists' Guild exhibit will not be accepted. Bin art will be accepted from previous exhibits. Artwork must have been completed in the last five years. The referees will check the artwork for compliance with the guidelines and have the right to refuse any entry that is deemed unsuitable.
- Complete entry forms for framed/3D art and/or bin art by Mar. 8.
- Registration is available online through the website with \$10 payment (online or by mail) or mail the entry form with payment to Alice Wych. Make checks payable to the Nature Artists' Guild.
- No changes will be made after submitting the registration form.
- Due to the Arboretum's non-profit status, no sale or removal of any artwork or bin art will be permitted during the exhibit. Prospective buyers may fill out a sales inquiry at the Information Table. Arrangements for sales may be completed after the show. Artists are asked to donate 15% of any sale resulting from the exhibit. Make checks payable to the Nature Artists' Guild and mail to the Treasurer.
- ALL EXHIBITING MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO VOLUNTEER TIME AT THE SHOW. Sign-up sheets will be available at guild meetings or contact: Lisa Kanellos or use the link below:

GUIDELINES FOR ACCEPTANCE OF ART INTO NATURE ARTISTS' GUILD EXHIBITIONS

The requirements for exhibition with the Nature Artists' Guild have a unique natural history focus.

SUBJECT MATTER

- All work submitted must show some aspect of nature with minimal human influence. Trees, plants, flowers, birds, insects, animals and natural landscapes are acceptable subjects. Pets and domesticated animals are unacceptable. Text, man-made objects and structures can be included as long as the primary focus is botanical or nature related.
- Art must be original from the artist's own observations.
- No mechanically reproduced prints are eligible for exhibition as framed art. Hand pulled prints and engravings are acceptable.

SCIENTIFIC CRITERIA

- Nomenclature, if used, must be accurate and correctly spelled.
- Plants and animals must be identifiable as to genus.
- Careful attention should be paid to appropriate natural history features such as ecological associations, animal behavior, scale relationships, and color.

ACCEPTABLE ART STYLES

- Scientific illustration which states genus and species.
- Landscapes can range from realistic to impressionistic, but need to show correct form and shape of plants and animals.
- **Design art** that incorporates plants, animals and natural forms.
- Colorist work which uses color to convey thoughts and emotions, but still have recognizable natural forms.
- Impressionistic art which consists of small brushstrokes that offer the bare impression of form.
- **Digitally painted artwork** that is original. Digital art needs to be professionally printed using archival ink and materials. The manipulation of scanned photographs or other digital images is not acceptable, unless traditional artistic elements are added.
- Other acceptable styles are at the discretion of the guild board and/or exhibit chairs.

MATTING AND FRAMING

- Matting and framing must be clean and of professional quality, using archival materials. No plastic or acrylic frames. The sides of canvas or wooden panels must be finished.
- All work to be hung must have firmly attached screw eyes or D-rings and picture hanging wire. The wire should NOT be flat and taut; there needs to be enough slack so that when you lift the wire with your finger, it forms a slight "tent" shape. Screw eyes or D-rings should be placed approximately one third of the way down from the: top of the frame. **No saw-tooth hangers are allowed.**
- ATTACH BUMPERS TO THE BACK OF EACH ART PIECE.
- Bin artwork must use quality matting, backing and polypropylene bags. No frames or plastic wrap.

SIZE REQUIREMENTS

- Framed artwork using glass or plexiglass: outside dimensions may not exceed 28" x 36". Canvas maximum outside dimensions: 40" x 30". Bin art may not exceed 30" x 30" including matting.
- Acceptance of any framed artwork that exceeds size limitations or is overly heavy with respect to the display panels will be at the discretion of the Exhibition Committee.
