Immerse yourself in a guided tour of Lilacia Park, led by an expert from the Lombard Historical Society. Whether you have a passion for history or a deep appreciation for lilacs, this journey promises to be a delightful experience for all.

Registration is strongly recommended before arriving. Tickets can be purchased at lombardhistory.org. Tours are \$9 per person, with group sizes limited to 16 individuals. The public tour commences at 11:00 am from the Carriage House at 23 W. Maple Street, it is advised to arrive 15 minutes before the tour. Refer to the website for additional details.
